AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in trade and commerce, requiring
3 sellers of cellular phones to keep a record of each sale; and
4 imposing a penalty.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 7332. Records of cellular phone sales.

10 (a) Requirement.--Any person who sells a cellular phone
11 shall require the purchaser to provide photo identification with
12 a home address and shall keep a record of the name and address
13 of the purchaser and a photocopy of the person's photo
14 identification for a period of at least one year from the date
15 of the sale.

16 (b) Penalty.--Any person who violates subsection (a) commits
17 a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to
18 pay a fine of \$100.

19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
