## AN ACT

- 1 Requiring the provision of a child's birth certificate, which
- shows the names and Social Security numbers of the child's
- father and mother, to receive benefits.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Benefits
- 8 Information Requirement Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Cash benefits." Cash benefits offered under the act of June
- 14 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code, or
- 15 any other act.
- 16 "Child." Any resident of this Commonwealth under 18 years of
- 17 age.
- 18 "State program." A State program offering cash benefits or

- 1 medical assistance.
- 2 "Medical assistance." The State program of medical
- 3 assistance established under the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31,
- 4 No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code.
- 5 Section 3. Information required.
- 6 No child or mother of a child, when applying for or receiving
- 7 benefits concerning the child, shall be eligible for benefits
- 8 from a State program unless the mother of the child provides to
- 9 the department administering the benefits a copy of the child's
- 10 birth certificate that shows the names and Social Security
- 11 numbers of the child's father and mother.
- 12 Section 10. Effective date.
- 13 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
