AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 30, 1981 (P.L.128, No.43), entitled "An
- act authorizing the creation of agricultural areas,"
- providing for proceeds from sales by the Department of
- Agriculture and for grants for agricultural land conservation
- 5 assistance; and making a related repeal.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The act of June 30, 1981 (P.L.128, No.43), known
- 9 as the Agricultural Area Security Law, is amended by adding
- 10 sections to read:
- 11 <u>Section 14.8. Proceeds from sale of land, equipment or</u>
- 12 facilities.
- 13 (a) Agricultural Conservation Easement Purchase Fund. --
- 14 Proceeds from the sale of all land, or portions of land,
- 15 equipment or facilities, transferred to the Department of
- 16 Agriculture under the act of June 18, 1982 (P.L.549, No.159),
- 17 entitled "An act providing for the administration of certain
- 18 Commonwealth farmland within the Department of Agriculture," and
- 19 subsequently disposed of by the Commonwealth under Article XXIV-

- 1 A of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as "The
- 2 Administrative Code of 1929, " shall, notwithstanding section 623
- 3 of "The Administrative Code of 1929" or any other provision of
- 4 the law to the contrary, be credited to the fund.
- 5 (b) State Farm Products Show Fund. -- Proceeds from the sale
- 6 of all land or portions of land, equipment or facilities at the
- 7 Woodville State Farm, Collier Township, Allegheny County, and
- 8 transferred to the Department of Agriculture under the act of
- 9 June 18, 1982 (P.L.549, No.159), and subsequently disposed of by
- 10 the Commonwealth under Article XXIV-A of "The Administrative"
- 11 Code of 1929" shall, notwithstanding any other provision of the
- 12 law to the contrary, be credited to the State Farm Products Show
- 13 Fund.
- 14 (c) Administrative Code. -- Section 623 of "The Administrative
- 15 Code of 1929," relating to disposition of Commonwealth assets,
- 16 <u>shall not apply to subsection (a) insofar as it is inconsistent</u>
- 17 with this section.
- 18 Section 14.9. Agricultural land conservation assistance grant
- 19 <u>program.</u>
- 20 (a) Authorization. -- The Department of Agriculture, in
- 21 consultation with the State Agricultural Land Preservation
- 22 Board, is hereby authorized to use up to \$200,000 of the funds
- 23 deposited into the Agricultural Conservation Easement Purchase
- 24 Fund under section 14.8(a) to make grants to counties for the
- 25 following purposes:
- 26 (1) To cover costs incurred by a county in creating a
- 27 spatial mapping database. Such database shall contain
- topographic data, property boundaries, soil boundaries, soil
- 29 <u>capability classes and soil productivity ratings.</u>
- 30 (2) To cover costs incurred by a county to train staff,

- 1 <u>contract with consultants and pay for computer software.</u>
- 2 (3) To assist counties in the development implementation
- 3 of agricultural zoning ordinances, including model ordinances
- for possible adoption by local government units.
- 5 (b) Limit. -- Grants made under subsection (a) shall not
- 6 exceed the lesser of \$10,000 or 50% of the costs incurred by the
- 7 county.
- 8 (c) Application. -- A county may submit an application for a
- 9 grant under this section to the department in such form and
- 10 manner and containing such documentation as the department, in
- 11 consultation with the State board, shall prescribe.
- 12 <u>(d) Criteria. -- The department, in consultation with the</u>
- 13 State board, shall establish eligibility criteria for awarding
- 14 grants for the purposes enumerated in subsection (a). No county
- 15 shall be eligible for more than an accumulative total of \$10,000
- 16 in grants annually pursuant to this section. A county which
- 17 receives a grant under this section but which fails to implement
- 18 <u>an agricultural conservation easement purchase program shall be</u>
- 19 required to repay the grant to the Commonwealth. Any such
- 20 repayments shall be credited to the fund and may be used for the
- 21 purposes of this section.
- 22 <u>(e) Administration.--The department shall administer the</u>
- 23 provisions of this section and is authorized, in consultation
- 24 with the State board, to adopt and promulgate regulations for
- 25 the administration and enforcement of the provisions of this
- 26 section.
- 27 Section 2. Repeals are as follows:
- 28 (1) The General Assembly declares that the repeal under
- 29 paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate the addition of
- 30 sections 14.8 and 14.9 of the act.

- 1 (2) Sections 7.1 and 7.3 of the act of June 18, 1982
- 2 (P.L.549, No.159), entitled "An act providing for the
- 3 administration of certain Commonwealth farmland within the
- 4 Department of Agriculture," are repealed.
- 5 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
