12	hereby enacts as follows:
13	Section 1. Section 11.2 of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.216,
14	No.76), known as The Dental Law, is amended by adding a
15	subsection to read:
16	* * *
17	(g) The board shall not limit the eligibility of dentists to
18	use a hospital or other medical facility for anesthesia services
19	or to receive payment for services rendered at a hospital or
20	other medical facility.
21	Section 2. The regulation of the Department of Public

Welfare at 55 Pa. Code § 1150.52(e) (relating to anesthesia
services) is abrogated to the extent that the regulation is
inconsistent with this act.

4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
