A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing separate and distinct amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for terms of members and for legislative districts.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
6	Section 1. The following amendments to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania are proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	(1) That section 3 of Article II be amended to read:
9	§ 3. Terms of members.
10	[Senators shall be elected for the term of four years and
11	Representatives for term of two years.]
12	(a) Senators shall be elected for the term of six years.
13	(b) Except as provided under subsection (c), Representatives
14	shall be elected for the term of four years.
15	(c) At the first general election in an even-numbered year
16	after the adoption of the amendment adding this subsection, all
17	Representatives from even-numbered districts shall be elected

for the term of four years and all Representatives from odd numbered districts shall be elected for the term of two years.
(2) That section 16 of Article II be amended to read:
§ 16. Legislative districts.

The Commonwealth shall be divided into [50] <u>37</u> senatorial and 5 6 [203] 185 representative districts, which shall be composed of 7 compact and contiguous territory as nearly equal in population 8 as practicable. Each senatorial district shall elect one Senator, and each representative district one Representative. No 9 10 representative district may be divided in the formation of a senatorial district. Unless absolutely necessary no county, 11 12 city, incorporated town, borough, township or ward shall be 13 divided in forming either a senatorial or representative 14 district.

15 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General 16 Assembly of these proposed constitutional amendments, the 17 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to 18 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article 19 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 20 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 21 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 22 passage of these proposed constitutional amendments.

23 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of these 24 proposed constitutional amendments, the Secretary of the 25 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the 26 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 27 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 28 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 29 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of these proposed constitutional amendments. 1 Commonwealth shall submit the proposed constitutional amendments 2 under section 1 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth as separate ballot questions at the first primary, general or 3 municipal election which meets the requirements of and is in 4 conformance with section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of 5 Pennsylvania and which occurs at least three months after the 6 proposed constitutional amendments are passed by the General 7 Assembly. 8
