- 12 (a) Offense defined. -- Any person who unintentionally causes
- 13 the death of another person as the direct result of a violation
- 14 of section 5502 (relating to operating watercraft under
- 15 influence of alcohol or controlled substance) and who is
- 16 convicted of violating section 5502 commits a felony of the
- 17 [third] <u>second</u> degree when the violation is the cause of death
- 18 and the sentencing court shall order the person to serve a
- 19 minimum term of imprisonment of not less than three years. A_
- 20 consecutive three-year term of imprisonment shall be imposed for
- 21 each victim whose death is the result of a violation of section
