Termination of utility service. * * * 10 11 (q) Qualification for LIHEAP. --12 (1) A notice of termination to a customer of a public 13 utility shall be sufficient proof of a crisis for a customer 14 with the requisite income level to receive a LIHEAP Crisis 15 Grant from the Department of Public Welfare or its designee. 16 (2) It shall be a condition of acceptance by a public 17 utility of a LIHEAP Crisis Grant from the Department of 18 Public Welfare or its designee that the public utility will

not terminate service to the customer within 60 days of

- 2 <u>agreement under section 1405(d) (relating to payment</u>
- 3 agreements) or, notwithstanding the provisions of section
- 4 1405(d), a second or subsequent payment agreement with the
