1 2 3 4	Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in rights and immunities, further providing for leaves of absence for certain government employees.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 4102 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 4102. Leaves of absence for certain government employees.
10	(a) Mandatory <u>leave</u>.
11	(1) The following shall apply:
12	(i) All officers and employees of a political
13	subdivision, or its instrumentalities, who are members of
14	the Pennsylvania National Guard, shall be [entitled to
15	leave of absence from their respective duties without
16	loss of pay, time or efficiency rating on all days during

which they shall, as members of the Pennsylvania National Guard, be engaged in active State duty. All such officers and employees shall, in addition, be] entitled to a leave of absence from their respective duties, in addition to regular vacation time, without loss of pay, time or efficiency rating on all days not exceeding 15—consecutive or nonconsecutive days in any one year during which they shall, as members of the Pennsylvania National—Guard [or], be engaged in State active duty or, as members of any reserve component of the armed forces of the United States, be engaged in training or other military duty under orders authorized by Federal or State—law.

dition, be entitled to unpaid leave of absence from their respective duties without loss of seniority or efficiency rating on all days in excess of the first 15 consecutive or nonconsecutive days per year during which they shall be engaged in training or other military duty under orders authorized by Federal or State law up to the maximum cumulative period authorized by 38 U.S.C. Ch. 43 (relating to employment and reemployment rights of members of the uniformed services).

(2) The following shall apply:

(i) All officers and employees of the Commonwealth or its instrumentalities who are members of the Pennsylvania National Guard shall be [entitled to leave of absence from their respective duties without loss of pay, time or efficiency rating on all days during which they shall, as members of the Pennsylvania National

1 Guard, be engaged in active State duty. All such officers 2 and employees shall, in addition, be entitled to a leave 3 of absence from their respective duties, in addition to regular vacation time, without loss of pay, time or 4 5 efficiency rating on all days not exceeding 15-6 consecutive or nonconsecutive days in any one year during-7 which they shall, as members of the Pennsylvania National Guard [or], be engaged in State active duty or, as 8 members of any reserve component of the armed forces of 9 10 the United States, be engaged in training or othermilitary duty under orders authorized by Federal or State 11 12 law. [In addition, when such] 13 (ii) Such officers and employees, when ordered to active duty for more than 30 days, other than active duty 14 for training, shall be entitled to up to 15 days of 15 16 additional military leave of absence in any one year, in addition to regular vacation time, without loss of pay, 17 18 time or efficiency rating under the following conditions: 19 (A) When ordered, involuntarily or under a 20 Contingency Operations Temporary Tour of Active Duty 21 (COTTAD) agreement; or 22 (B) When ordered voluntarily to serve in a 23 combat zone or in response to a domestic emergency[,-24 to active duty, other than active duty for training, 25 for a period of 30 or more consecutive days and]. 26 (iii) Clauses (A) and (B) shall apply only toofficers and employees who have been assigned to duties-27 28 away from home station, and when such duty is ordered 29 under 10 U.S.C. § 12301 (relating to Reserve components generally), 12302 (relating to Ready Reserve) or 12304 30

(relating to Selected Reserve and certain Individual
Ready Reserve members; order to active duty other than
during war or national emergency) or 32 U.S.C. § 502 (f)

(relating to required drills and field exercises), [they]
the officers and employees shall be entitled to up to 15
days of additional military leave of absence in any one
year without loss of pay, time and efficiency rating.

(iv) All such officers and employees shall, in addition, be entitled to unpaid leave of absence from their respective duties without loss of seniority or efficiency rating on all days in excess of 30 days per year during which they shall be engaged in training or other military duty under orders authorized by Federal or State law up to the maximum cumulative period authorized by 38 U.S.C. Ch. 43.

(b) Discretionary <u>leave</u>. The Commonwealth, its instrumentalities and political subdivisions [thereof] and their-instrumentalities shall be authorized and permitted to provide paid military leave or other compensation and/or continue medical and other benefits to members of the Pennsylvania National Guard and other reserve components of the United States Armed Forces for days in excess of those provided in subsection-(a) when the member shall be engaged in training or other military duty under orders authorized by Federal or State law. (c) Return from leave. An officer or employee to whom this section applies shall not be required to return to duty within 18 hours of having been relieved of Federal or State active duty, but the officer or employee may choose to return to duty

within that period of time.
