AN ACT

Amending the act of December 19, 1996 (P.L.1478, No.190), 1 entitled "An act relating to the recycling and reuse of waste 2 tires; providing for the proper disposal of waste tires and 3 the cleanup of stockpiled tires; authorizing investment tax 4 credits for utilizing waste tires; providing remediation 5 grants for the cleanup of tire piles and for pollution 6 prevention programs for small business and households; 7 establishing the Small Business and Household Pollution 8 9 Prevention Program and management standards for small business hazardous waste; providing for a household hazardous 10 waste program and for grant programs; making appropriations; 11 and making repeals," in small business and household 12 pollution prevention program, further providing for grants 13 for collection agents. 14 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

16 hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 209(d) of the act of December 19, 1996 (P.L.1478, No.190), entitled "An act relating to the recycling and reuse of waste tires; providing for the proper disposal of waste tires and the cleanup of stockpiled tires; authorizing investment tax credits for utilizing waste tires; providing remediation grants for the cleanup of tire piles and for

1 pollution prevention programs for small business and households; establishing the Small Business and Household Pollution 2 3 Prevention Program and management standards for small business hazardous waste; providing for a household hazardous waste 4 program and for grant programs; making appropriations; and 5 making repeals," is amended to read: 6 Section 209. Grants for collection events. 7 * * * 8 9 (d) Other limitations.--10 (1) No more than [\$100,000] <u>\$150,000</u> per fiscal year may 11 be expended by the department for collection events in any 12 one county. 13 (2) A grant approved by the department under this 14 section to any county having a population of less than 15 250,000 under the most recent Federal decennial census shall not exceed \$100,000 during any fiscal year. 16 17 (3) A grant approved by the department under this 18 section to any county having a population of 250,000 or more 19 during the most recent Federal decennial census shall not 20 exceed \$150,000 during any fiscal year. 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
