AN ACT

Amending the act of June 28, 1995 (P.L.89, No.18), entitled "An act creating the Department of Conservation and Natural 1 2 Resources consisting of certain functions of the Department 3 of Environmental Resources and the Department of Community 4 Affairs; renaming the Department of Environmental Resources 5 as the Department of Environmental Protection; defining the 6 role of the Environmental Quality Board in the Department of 7 8 Environmental Protection; making changes to responsibilities of the State Conservation Commission and the Department of 9 Agriculture; transferring certain powers and duties to the 10 Department of Health; and repealing inconsistent acts," 11 providing for certified lifequards in State parks with public 12 13 beaches. 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows:

16 Section 1. The act of June 28, 1995 (P.L.89, No.18), known

17 as the Conservation and Natural Resources Act, is amended by

19 <u>Section 323. Certified lifeguards in State parks with public</u>

20 <u>beaches.</u>

21 <u>The department shall employ a sufficient number of certified</u>

- 1 lifeguards to provide water safety and lifesaving services to
- 2 patrons in each State park that has a public beach during such
- 3 times as the public beach is open to patrons.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
