Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for powers and duties of Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. 18	(16) TO ASSESS, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF
19	MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS, THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
20	OTHER STATE, COMMUNITY OR LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS AND AGENCIES
21	THAT HAVE EXPERTISE IN THE FIELD OF TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY
22	(TBI) AND POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER (PTSD), THE TRAINING
23	NEEDS OF POLICE OFFICERS ON RECOGNIZING AND INTERACTING WITH
24	VETERANS AND OTHER INDIVIDUALS SUFFERING FROM TBI OR PTSD.
25	SHOULD THE COMMISSION DETERMINE THAT THERE IS A NEED FOR
26	SPECIALIZED TRAINING ON TBI AND PTSD, THE COMMISSION SHALL
27	DEVELOP A TRAINING COURSE THAT SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO ALL
28	POLICE OFFICERS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES WITHIN THIS
29	COMMONWEALTH.
