1 2 3	Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in divorce, further providing for counseling.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 3302 of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8	§ 3302. Counseling.
9	* * *
10	(d.1) Universal
11	(1) This subsection applies:
12	(i) regardless of the ground for divorce; and
13	(ii) in addition to other counseling required by
14	this section.
15	(2) The court shall require up to a maximum of three
16	counseling sessions, to prepare the parties to deal with all
17	of the following:
18	(i) Anger management.
19	(ii) Applicability and implementation of Chapter 61

1	(relating to protection from abuse).
2	(iii) Effect of the behavior of the parties on any
3	child who resides with either party. Counseling under
4	this subparagraph shall not distinguish on the basis of:
5	(A) when the behavior occurs as related to an
6	order under section 3323(a) (relating to decree of
7	<pre>court); or</pre>
8	(B) whether the child is a child of the marriage
9	subject to divorce.

11	Section 2. The addition of 23 Pa.C.S. § 3302(d.1) shall
12	apply to actions initiated on or after the effective date of
13	this section.
