AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 2 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 3 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; 5 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; 7 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 9 10 elections," in primary and election expenses, further 11 providing for definitions and for reporting by candidate and 12 political committees and other persons. 13 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. Section 1621 of the act of June 3, 1937 17 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is 18 amended by adding a subsection to read: 19 Section 1621. Definitions. -- As used in this article, the 20 following words have the following meanings: * * * 21 (n) The word "intermediary" shall mean any person, political 22

- 1 committee or other entity which, other than in the regular
- 2 course of business as a postal, delivery or messenger service,
- 3 <u>delivers any contribution from another person, political</u>
- 4 <u>committee or other entity to a candidate or political committee</u>
- 5 or solicits contributions for a candidate or political committee
- 6 where such solicitation is known to such candidate or the
- 7 candidate's authorized committee. The term shall not include
- 8 spouses, domestic partners, parents, children or siblings of the
- 9 person making such contribution or any fundraising agent.
- Section 2. Section 1626(b) of the act, added October 4, 1978
- 11 (P.L.893, No.171), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 1626. Reporting by Candidate and Political
- 13 Committees and other Persons. --
- 14 * * *
- 15 (b) Each report shall include the following information:
- 16 (1) The full name, mailing address, occupation and name of
- 17 employer, if any, or the principal place of business, if self-
- 18 employed, of each person who has made one or more contributions
- 19 to or for such committee or candidate within the reporting
- 20 period in an aggregate amount or value in excess of two hundred
- 21 fifty dollars (\$250), together with the amount and date of such
- 22 contributions. The full name, mailing address, occupation and
- 23 name of the employer, if any, or the principal place of
- 24 business, if self-employed, of each intermediary, if any, and
- 25 each person who has made one or more contributions to be
- 26 delivered by the intermediary to a committee or candidate. The
- 27 accuracy of the information furnished to the candidate or
- 28 committee shall be the responsibility of the contributor and the
- 29 <u>intermediary</u>, if any.
- 30 (2) The full name and mailing address of each person who has

- 1 made one or more contributions to or for such committee or
- 2 candidate within the reporting period in an aggregate amount or
- 3 value in excess of fifty dollars (\$50), together with the amount
- 4 and date of such contributions. The accuracy of the information
- 5 furnished by the contributor shall be the responsibility of the
- 6 contributor.
- 7 (3) The total sum of individual contributions made to or for
- 8 such committee or candidate during the reporting period and not
- 9 reported under clauses (1) and (2).
- 10 (4) Each and every expenditure, the date made, the full name
- 11 and address of the person to whom made and the purpose for which
- 12 such expenditure was made.
- 13 (5) Any unpaid debts and liabilities, with the nature and
- 14 amount of each, the date incurred and the full name and address
- 15 of the person owed.
- 16 (6) The account shall include any unexpended balance of
- 17 contributions or other receipts appearing from the last account
- 18 filed.

- 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
