## AN ACT

Amending the act of December 19, 1990 (P.L.1200, No.202), entitled "An act providing for the registration and 2 regulation of solicitations by charitable organizations, 3 professional fundraisers and other solicitors; imposing additional powers on the Department of State and the Office of Attorney General; prescribing civil and criminal penalties; and making a repeal," further providing for information filed to become public records. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. Section 11 of the act of December 19, 1990 12 (P.L.1200, No.202), known as the Solicitation of Funds for 13 Charitable Purposes Act, is amended to read: 14 Section 11. Information filed to become public records. 15 (a) General rule. -- Except as otherwise provided in section 16 12, registration statements and applications, reports, notices, 17 contracts or agreements between charitable organizations and 18 professional fundraising counsel, professional solicitors and commercial conventurers, and all other documents and information 19 20 required to be filed under this act with the department shall be

- 1 <u>filed electronically and</u> become public records in the office of
- 2 the bureau and shall be open to the general public at such time
- 3 and under such conditions as the department may prescribe and
- 4 <u>shall be made available to the general public without charge</u>
- 5 through a searchable database on the department's publicly
- 6 accessible Internet website.
- 7 (b) Duty of secretary. -- The secretary shall develop an
- 8 <u>electronic filing system for all documents and information</u>
- 9 required to be filed with the department under this act. The
- 10 system shall be operational no later than January 1, 2014.
- 11 (c) Restricted account. -- The Solicitation of Funds for
- 12 Charitable Purposes Account is established as a restricted
- 13 account within the General Fund. All of the following fees shall
- 14 be deposited into the account and shall be used exclusively for
- 15 the purpose of establishing and maintaining the searchable
- 16 <u>database and electronic filing system required by this section:</u>
- 17 (1) The annual registration fees for charitable
- organizations under section 5(p).
- 19 (2) The late filing fees for charitable organizations
- 20 <u>under section 5(q).</u>
- 21 (3) The annual registration fees for professional
- fundraising counsels under section 8(b).
- 23 (4) The annual registration fees for professional
- solicitors under section 9(b).
- 25 (5) The contract filing fee for professional solicitors
- 26 under section 9(e).
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
