## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for court
- 3 reporting contracts.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:
- 8 CHAPTER 46
- 9 <u>COURT REPORTING CONTRACTS</u>

- 11 4601. Short title of chapter.
- 12 4602. Definitions.
- 13 4603. Prohibited contract provisions.
- 14 4604. Applicability.
- 15 4605. Action to recover damages.
- 16 § 4601. Short title of chapter.
- 17 This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the Court
- 18 Reporting Contract Act.
- 19 § 4602. Definitions.

- 1 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 2 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 3 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 4 "Court reporter." A person who makes, by a written system of
- 5 <u>either manual shorthand or stenotype or by use of a stenomask or</u>
- 6 any other means, a verbatim record of any adjudicatory or
- 7 <u>testimonial proceeding</u>, <u>public hearing or testimony given under</u>
- 8 <u>oath.</u>
- 9 § 4603. Prohibited contract provisions.
- 10 A contract entered into between a court reporter or a court
- 11 reporting firm and an attorney, a law firm, a party to a legal
- 12 proceeding or a party having a financial interest in a legal
- 13 proceeding shall not include provisions that:
- 14 (1) Undermine the impartiality of the court reporter by:
- (i) Failing to charge all parties to the legal
- 16 <u>proceeding or their attorneys the same price for copies</u>
- of a transcript or the same price for like services
- 18 performed in the legal proceeding.
- 19 (ii) Failing to provide copies of a transcript to
- all parties to the legal proceeding, or their attorneys,
- 21 simultaneously with the delivery of the original.
- 22 (2) Require the court reporter to provide any service to
- a party to the legal proceeding not offered to the other
- 24 parties.
- 25 (3) Otherwise give an advantage to a party to the legal
- 26 proceeding over the other parties.
- 27 § 4604. Applicability.
- 28 (a) Government agency. -- This chapter shall not apply to a
- 29 contract for court reporting services to which a court, agency
- 30 or instrumentality of the United States or the Commonwealth is a

- 1 party.
- 2 (b) Court rulemaking authority. -- This chapter shall not be
- 3 <u>construed to preclude or supersede the authority exercised by</u>
- 4 the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania under section 10 of Article V
- 5 of the Constitution of Pennsylvania.
- 6 § 4605. Action to recover damages.
- 7 A party to a legal proceeding or a party having a financial
- 8 <u>interest in a legal proceeding</u>, or that party's attorney, who
- 9 <u>suffers any ascertainable loss of money or property as a result</u>
- 10 of the provision of a contract that violates this chapter may
- 11 bring a private action against the parties to the contract in
- 12 order to recover up to three times the actual damages suffered
- 13 or \$100, whichever is greater. The court may provide additional
- 14 relief, including injunctive relief, as it deems necessary and
- 15 proper. The court shall award reasonable attorney fees to a
- 16 person who prevails in an action brought under this section.
- 17 Section 2. The addition of 42 Pa.C.S. Ch. 46 shall apply to
- 18 contracts entered into on or after the effective date of this
- 19 section.
- 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
