## AN ACT

- 1 Prohibiting employers from using consumer reports under certain 2 circumstances; and providing for enforcement.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Employer Use
- 7 of Consumer Report Act.
- 8 Section 2. Prohibition.
- 9 No employer or potential employer shall procure a consumer
- 10 report for employment purposes if any information contained in
- 11 the report bears on the employee's or potential employee's
- 12 credit worthiness, credit standing or credit capacity, unless
- 13 the information is either:
- 14 (1) substantially job related and the employer's or
- 15 potential employer's reasons for the use of the information
- are disclosed to the employee or potential employee in
- 17 writing, in which case, the burden of proof shall be on the

- 1 employer or potential employer to demonstrate that the
- 2 employee's or potential employee's credit worthiness, credit
- 3 standing or credit capacity is substantially job related; or
- 4 (2) required by law.
- 5 Section 3. Enforcement.
- A violation of section 2 shall constitute an unlawful
- 7 discriminatory practice for purposes of section 5 of the act of
- 8 October 27, 1955 (P.L.744, No.222), known as the Pennsylvania
- 9 Human Relations Act, and shall be subject to enforcement as
- 10 provided under that act.
- 11 Section 10. Effective date.
- 12 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
