9	(a) Annual safety inspection
10	(1) Except as provided in subsection (b), the department
11	shall establish a system of annual safety inspection of
12	vehicles, including emergency vehicles, farm vehicles with a
13	gross weight or gross vehicle weight rating of greater than
14	17,000 pounds for which a Type I biennial certificate of
15	exemption has been issued and private noncommercial vehicles
16	used to transport students.
17	(2) The system of annual safety inspection shall provide
18	that the certificate of inspection on a new vehicle shall
