AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in offenses against the family, further providing for the offense of endangering welfare of 3 children. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 4304(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 9 § 4304. Endangering welfare of children. * * * 10 11 (b) Grading. -- [An] 12 (1) Except as provided under paragraphs (2) and (3), an offense under this section constitutes a misdemeanor of the 13 14 first degree. [However, where] 15 (2) If there is a course of conduct of endangering the 16 welfare of a child, the offense constitutes a felony of the 17 third degree.

(3) If an offense under this section is the result of

- 1 <u>leaving a child under 13 years of age in a motor vehicle</u>
- 2 without adult supervision, the offense constitutes a felony
- 3 <u>of the third degree.</u>
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
