## AN ACT

- Amending the act of February 2, 1966 (1965 P.L.1860, No.586), 1 entitled "An act encouraging landowners to make land and 2 water areas available to the public for recreational purposes 3 by limiting liability in connection therewith, and repealing 4 certain acts," providing for a short title; further providing 5 for definitions; and making editorial changes. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of February 2, 1966 (1965)
- 10 P.L.1860, No.586), entitled "An act encouraging landowners to
- 11 make land and water areas available to the public for

- 14 (P.L.42, No.11), is repealed:
- 15 [Section 1. The purpose of this act is to encourage owners
- 16 of land to make land and water areas available to the public for
- 17 recreational purposes by limiting their liability.]
- 18 Section 2. The act is amended by adding sections to read:
- 19 <u>Section 1.1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the</u>

- 1 "Recreational Use of Land and Water Act."
- 2 Section 1.2. The purpose of this act is to encourage owners
- 3 of land to make land and water areas available to the public for
- 4 <u>recreational purposes by limiting their liability.</u>
- 5 Section 3. Section 2 of the act, amended March 26, 1992
- 6 (P.L.27, No.10), is amended to read:
- 7 Section 2. [As used in this act:] The following words and
- 8 phrases when used in this act shall have the meanings given to
- 9 them in this section unless the context clearly indicates
- 10 otherwise:
- 11 "Charge." The admission price or fee asked in return for
- 12 <u>invitation or permission to enter or go upon the land.</u>
- [(1) "Land" means land] "Land." Land, roads, TRAILS, water,
- 14 watercourses, private ways and buildings, structures and
- 15 machinery or equipment when attached to the realty. The term
- 16 <u>includes nature trails.</u>
- [(2) "Owner" means the] <u>"Owner." The</u> possessor of a fee
- 18 interest, a tenant, lessee, occupant or person in control of the
- 19 premises.
- 20 [(3) "Recreational purpose" includes] "Recreational"
- 21 purpose." The term includes, but is not limited to, any of the
- 22 following, or any combination thereof: hunting, fishing,
- 23 swimming, boating, camping, picnicking, hiking, pleasure
- 24 driving, nature study, water skiing, water sports, cave
- 25 exploration and viewing or enjoying historical, archaeological,
- 26 scenic, or scientific sites, and walking, jogging, bicycling,
- 27 <u>exercising and horseback riding on nature trails</u>.
- [(4) "Charge" means the admission price or fee asked in
- 29 return for invitation or permission to enter or go upon the
- 30 land.]

1 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
