AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in juvenile matters,
- providing for disposition information.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 6352 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 6352. Disposition of delinquent child.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (c) Required statement of reasons. -- Prior to entering an
- 11 order of disposition under subsection (a), the court shall state
- 12 the reasons for its disposition on the record in open court,
- 13 together with the goals, terms and conditions of that
- 14 <u>disposition</u>. If the child is to be committed to out-of-home
- 15 placement, the court shall also state the name of the specific
- 16 <u>facility</u>, or type of facility, to which the child will be
- 17 committed and the reasons why commitment to that facility, or
- 18 type of facility, was determined to be the least restrictive

- 1 placement that is consistent with the protection of the public
- 2 <u>interest and best suited to the child's treatment, supervision,</u>
- 3 rehabilitation and welfare.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
