- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated

 Statutes, in accidents and accident reports, further

 providing for the offense of aggidents involving death or

- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 3742(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by
- 9 adding a subsection to read:
- 10 § 3742. Accidents involving death or personal injury.
- 11 * * *
- 12 (b) Penalties.--
- 13 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any
- person violating this section commits a [misdemeanor] <u>felony</u>
- of the [first] third degree and the sentencing court shall
- order the person to pay a fine of not less than \$1,000.
- 17 (2) If the victim suffers serious bodily injury, any
- 18 person violating subsection (a) commits a felony of the third
- degree, and the sentencing court shall order the person to

serve a minimum term of imprisonment of not less than 90 days

2 and a mandatory minimum fine of \$1,000, notwithstanding any

other provision of law. An additional fine and consecutive

4 <u>minimum term of imprisonment under this subsection shall be</u>

5 <u>imposed for each victim.</u>

(a) If the victim dies, any person violating subsection

(a) commits a felony of the [third] second degree, and the sentencing court shall order the person to serve a minimum term of imprisonment of not less than one year and a mandatory minimum fine of \$2,500, notwithstanding any other provision of law. An additional fine and consecutive minimum term of imprisonment under this subsection shall be imposed for each victim.

- (b.1) Enhanced penalties. --
- 15 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, any
 16 person who violates this section concurrently with a
 17 violation of section 3802 (relating to driving under
 18 influence of alcohol or controlled substance) and who is
 19 convicted of violating section 3802 commits a felony of the
 20 second degree.
 - (2) If the victim suffers serious bodily injury, any person who violates subsection (a) concurrently with a violation of section 3735.1 (relating to aggravated assault by vehicle while driving under the influence) and who is convicted of violating section 3735.1 commits a felony of the second degree, and the sentencing court shall order the person to serve a minimum term of imprisonment of not less than one year and a mandatory fine of \$5,000, notwithstanding any other provision of law. An additional fine and minimum term of imprisonment under this subsection shall be imposed

- 1 <u>for each victim.</u>
- 2 (3) If the victim dies, any person who violates
- 3 subsection (a) concurrently with a violation of section 3735
- 4 <u>(relating to homicide by vehicle while driving under</u>
- 5 <u>influence</u>) and who is convicted of violating section 3735
- 6 commits a felony of the second degree, and the sentencing
- 7 <u>court shall order the person to serve a minimum term of</u>
- 8 <u>imprisonment of not less than three years and a mandatory</u>
- 9 <u>fine of \$10,000, notwithstanding any other provision of law.</u>
- 10 An additional fine and minimum term of imprisonment under
- this subsection shall be imposed for each victim. The
- 12 <u>mandatory imprisonment sentences under this subsection shall</u>
- run consecutively to any mandatory sentence imposed under
- section 3735 and any mandatory sentence imposed under
- subsection (b.1)(2) of this section.
