1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for exceptions to prohibition of interception and disclosure of communications.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 5704 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
8	§ 5704. Exceptions to prohibition of interception and
9	disclosure of communications.
10	It shall not be unlawful and no prior court approval shall be
11	required under this chapter for:
12	* * *
13	(17) A person to intercept oral communications for
14	disciplinary or security purposes on a school bus or school
15	vehicle, as those terms are defined in 75 Pa.C.S. § 102_
16	(relating to definitions), if all of the following conditions
17	<u>are met:</u>
18	(i) The school board has adopted a policy that

1	authorizes audio interception on school buses or school
2	vehicles for disciplinary or security purposes.
3	(ii) Each school year, the school board notifies
4	students and their parents or guardians of the policy, by
5	letter mailed to the students' home addresses.
6	(iii) The school board posts a notice that students
7	may be audiotaped, which notice is clearly visible on
8	each school bus or school vehicle that is furnished with
9	audio-recording equipment.
10	This paragraph shall not apply when a school bus or school
11	vehicle is used for a purpose that is not school related.
12	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
