## A SUPPLEMENT

To the act of July 7, 1972 (P.L.743, No.176), entitled "An act 2 providing for the establishment and operation of Lincoln University as an instrumentality of the Commonwealth to serve 3 as a State-related institution in the higher education system 4 of the Commonwealth; providing for change of name; providing for the composition of the board of trustees; terms of 7 trustees, and the power and duties of such trustees; providing for preference to Pennsylvania residents in tuition; authorizing appropriations in amounts to be fixed 9 annually by the General Assembly; providing for the auditing 10 of accounts of expenditures from said appropriations; 11 providing for public support and capital improvements; authorizing the issuance of bonds exempt from taxation within 12 13 the Commonwealth; requiring the President to make an annual report of the operations of Lincoln University," making an 14 15 appropriation for carrying the same into effect; providing 16 for a basis for payments of the appropriation; and providing 17 a method of accounting for the funds appropriated and for 18 certain fiscal information disclosure. 19 20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 21 hereby enacts as follows: 22 Section 1. The sum of \$11,163,000, or as much thereof as may 23 be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Trustees of Lincoln 24 University, Chester County, for the fiscal year <del>July 1, 2011, to</del> 25 June 30, 2012 JULY 1, 2012, TO JUNE 30, 2013, for general

- 1 Section 2. Payments to Lincoln University on account of the
- 2 appropriation provided in section 1 shall be made on the basis
- 3 of costs during the fiscal year.
- 4 Section 3. (a) Payments to Lincoln University of the
- 5 appropriation provided in section 1 shall be made monthly during
- 6 the fiscal year.
- 7 (b) Such monthly payments shall be made in accordance with
- 8 the provisions of section 2 on the basis of estimated costs. The
- 9 estimate of costs shall be submitted by Lincoln University to
- 10 the Secretary of Education, the General Assembly and the State
- 11 Treasurer not later than 30 days prior to the date on which such
- 12 payment is to be made.
- 13 Section 4. (a) Lincoln University shall apply the moneys
- 14 appropriated by this act only for such purposes as are permitted
- 15 in this act and shall at all times maintain proper records
- 16 showing the application of such moneys. Not later than 120 days
- 17 after the close of the fiscal year to which this act relates,
- 18 Lincoln University shall file, with the Secretary of Education,
- 19 the General Assembly and the Auditor General of the
- 20 Commonwealth, a statement setting forth the amounts and purposes
- 21 of all expenditures made from moneys appropriated by this act
- 22 and costs, as provided in section 2, used as a basis for receipt
- 23 of any appropriation during said fiscal year.
- 24 (b) Such statement of expenditures and costs shall be
- 25 reviewed by the Auditor General of the Commonwealth, and he
- 26 shall have the right, in respect to the moneys appropriated by
- 27 this act, to audit and disallow expenditures made for purposes
- 28 not permitted by this act and to cause such sums to be recovered
- 29 and paid by Lincoln University to the State Treasurer. In
- 30 respect to expenditures made by the university from moneys other

- 1 than those appropriated by this act, the Auditor General shall
- 2 have the right to review only, and he shall file annually with
- 3 the General Assembly such information concerning said
- 4 expenditures as the General Assembly or any of its committees
- 5 may require.
- 6 Section 5. The Lincoln University shall provide full,
- 7 complete and accurate information as may be required by the
- 8 Department of Education or the chairman or the minority chairman
- 9 of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the chairman or
- 10 the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the
- 11 House of Representatives.
- 12 Section 6. Lincoln University shall present and report its
- 13 financial statements required under the provisions of this act
- 14 in accordance with: the generally accepted accounting principles
- 15 as prescribed by the National Association of College and
- 16 University Business Officers, the American Institute of
- 17 Certified Public Accountants, or their successors, or by any
- 18 other recognized authoritative body; the "Commonwealth of
- 19 Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of Higher
- 20 Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-Related
- 21 Colleges and Universities"; and the financial reporting policies
- 22 and standards promulgated by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 23 and by the Federal Government that apply to Lincoln University.
- Section 7. This act shall take effect July 1, <del>2011</del> 2012, or
- 25 immediately, whichever is later.
