(3) aircraft refueling vehicles or vehicles and combinations carrying raw milk, raw coal, flat-rolled steel coils, steel slabs, hot ingots, a hot box, pulpwood and wood chips [or], raw water or cryogenic liquid which exceed the maximum weight specified in Subchapter C while they are in the course of manufacture and under contract with or under the direct control of the manufacturer, provided that they do

- 6 (13) A combination of vehicles that hauls cryogenic

- 10 <u>their respective jurisdiction if the gross weight does not</u>
