AN ACT
Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for speed timing devices.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 3368(d) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 3368. Speed timing devices.

(d) Classification, approval and testing of mechanical, electrical and electronic devices.--The department may, by regulation, classify specific devices as being mechanical, electrical or electronic. All mechanical, electrical or electronic devices shall be of a type approved by the department, which shall appoint stations for calibrating and testing the devices and may prescribe regulations as to the manner in which calibrations and tests shall be made. The certification and calibration of electronic devices under subsection (c) (3) shall also include the certification and

7 accuracy within a period of [60 days] six months prior to the 8 alleged violation. A certificate from the station showing that

9 the calibration and test were made within the required period
calibration of all equipment, timing strips and other devices which are actually used with the particular electronic device being certified and calibrated. Electronic devices commonly referred to as electronic speed meters or radar shall have been tested for accuracy within a period of one year prior to the alleged violation. Other devices shall have been tested for and that the device was accurate shall be competent and prima facie evidence of those facts in every proceeding in which a violation of this title is charged.
