7	Section 1. Section 2707(a) of Title 30 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 2707. Disabled veterans and former prisoners of war.
10	(a) General rule for disabled veteransAny disabled
11	veteran who has a disability incurred in any war or armed
12	conflict which consists of the loss of one or more limbs, or the
13	loss of use of one or more limbs, or total blindness, or who is
14	[100%] 50% disabled as certified by the United States Department
15	of Veterans Affairs, and who meets the qualifications of section
16	2701 (relating to resident fishing licenses), shall be issued a
17	free resident fishing license upon application to the commission

or a county treasurer. An application submitted by a disabled veteran shall, in addition to any information required under section 2701, contain a statement that the applicant is a war or armed conflict veteran and that the qualifying disability was service incurred. The issuing agent or the commission may require the production of the discharge papers of the applicant. * * *

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
