## AN ACT

Amending the act of December 3, 1959 (P.L.1688, No.621), entitled, as amended, "An act to promote the health, safety 2 3 and welfare of the people of the Commonwealth by broadening the market for housing for persons and families of low and 4 moderate income and alleviating shortages thereof, and by assisting in the provision of housing for elderly persons 6 7 through the creation of the Pennsylvania Housing Finance 8 Agency as a public corporation and government instrumentality; providing for the organization, membership 9 and administration of the agency, prescribing its general 10 powers and duties and the manner in which its funds are kept 11 and audited, empowering the agency to make housing loans to 12 13 qualified mortgagors upon the security of insured and uninsured mortgages, defining qualified mortgagors and 14 providing for priorities among tenants in certain instances, 15 prescribing interest rates and other terms of housing loans, 16 permitting the agency to acquire real or personal property, 17 permitting the agency to make agreements with financial 18 institutions and Federal agencies, providing for the purchase 19 by persons of low and moderate income of housing units, and 20 approving the sale of housing units, permitting the agency to 21 sell housing loans, providing for the promulgation of 22 23 regulations and forms by the agency, prescribing penalties 24 for furnishing false information, empowering the agency to borrow money upon its own credit by the issuance and sale of 25 bonds and notes and by giving security therefor, permitting 26 the refunding, redemption and purchase of such obligations by 27 the agency, prescribing remedies of holders of such bonds and 28 notes, exempting bonds and notes of the agency, the income 29 therefrom, and the income and revenues of the agency from 30 taxation, except transfer, death and gift taxes; making such 31 bonds and notes legal investments for certain purposes; and 32 indicating how the act shall become effective," providing for 33

- an annual transfer to the Homeowner's Emergency Mortgage
- 2 Assistance Fund.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 408-C of the act of December 3, 1959
- 6 (P.L.1688, No.621), known as the Housing Finance Agency Law,
- 7 amended December 21, 1998 (P.L.1248, No.160), is amended to
- 8 read:
- 9 Section 408-C. Homeowner's Emergency Mortgage Assistance
- 10 Fund. -- The Homeowner's Emergency Mortgage Assistance Fund is
- 11 hereby created as a separate account within the agency for the
- 12 sole purpose of implementing the provisions of this article.
- 13 Beginning July 1, 2012, and each July 1 thereafter, the
- 14 Department of Revenue shall transfer the sum of \$15,000,000 from
- 15 the amount received by the Department of Revenue under 4 Pa.C.S.
- 16 § 13A62 (relating to table games taxes) to the agency for
- 17 <u>deposit into the fund.</u> No other agency funds, moneys or interest
- 18 earnings shall be utilized for the purposes of this article.
- 19 Investment and interest earnings on moneys from this fund may be
- 20 used by the agency for the administrative costs of the program.
- 21 The Homeowner's Emergency Mortgage Assistance Fund shall operate
- 22 as a revolving loan fund to which shall be credited all
- 23 repayment of principal and interest by mortgagors to the agency
- 24 to repay loans provided by the agency pursuant to this article
- 25 as well as grants or donations from other sources and any funds
- 26 that may be appropriated by the General Assembly.
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
