- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in reimbursements by Commonwealth and 5 between school districts, further providing for extraordinary 6 special education program expenses. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 2509.8 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 11 12 amended by adding a subsection to read: 13 Section 2509.8. Extraordinary Special Education Program Expenses. --* * * 14
- (f) For the 2012-2013 school year and each school year
- 16 thereafter, funds from the set-aside contained in subsection (e)
- 17 shall be allocated to each approved private school with a day
- 18 tuition rate determined to be less than thirty-two thousand
- 19 dollars (\$32,000) during the 2010-2011 school year. For each
- 20 <u>such approved school the allocation shall be determined by</u>
- 21 subtracting the approved private school's 2010-2011 school year

- 1 day tuition rate from thirty-eight thousand three hundred five
- 2 <u>dollars (\$38,305)</u> and multiplying the result by the number of
- 3 approved students enrolled in the approved private school during
- 4 <u>the 2010-2011 school year.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012, or
- 6 immediately, whichever is later.
