AN ACT

Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for 2 the offense of scattering rubbish and for the offense of 3 depositing of waste and other material on highway, property 4 or waters. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 6501(b)(1) and (2) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 10 § 6501. Scattering rubbish. 11 12 (b) Penalty.--13 A person who violates subsection (a)(1) or (2) is 14 quilty of a summary offense for the first offense and upon 15 conviction thereof shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not 16 less than [\$50 nor more than \$300] \$1,000 or to imprisonment 17 for not more than 90 days, or both.

A person who violates subsection (a)(1) or (2) is

quilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree for the second

- and subsequent offense and upon conviction thereof shall be
- 2 sentenced to pay a fine of not less than [\$300 nor more than]
- 3 \$1,000. The person also may be sentenced to imprisonment or
- 4 to performing a community service for a period not to exceed
- 5 one year.

- 12 (d) Penalty. -- Any person violating any of the provisions of
- 13 subsection (a) or (b) commits a summary offense and shall, upon
- 14 conviction, be sentenced to either or both of the following:
- 15 (1) To pay [a fine of not more than]:
- (i) [\$900] for a violation which occurs in an
- 17 easement purchased under the program established by
- 18 section 14.1 of the act of June 30, 1981 (P.L.128,
- No.43), known as the Agricultural Area Security Law, a
- fine of not less than \$1,000;
