AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for additional certificates
- and medallions for wheelchair-accessible taxicabs; and
- 4 establishing the Wheelchair-Accessible Taxicab Program.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 53 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 5717.1. Additional certificates and medallions for
- 10 <u>wheelchair-accessible taxicabs.</u>
- 11 (a) Auction of certificates and medallions.--In addition to
- 12 the certificates authorized under section 5711 (relating to
- 13 power of authority to issue certificates of public convenience),
- 14 the authority shall issue an additional 200 certificates and
- 15 corresponding medallions exclusively for wheelchair-accessible
- 16 <u>taxicabs in a city of the first class. Not later than 120 days</u>
- 17 after the effective date of this section, the medallions shall
- 18 be auctioned by the authority at market rate.

- 1 (b) Program. -- The Wheelchair-Accessible Taxicab Program is
- 2 hereby established. The authority shall promulgate rules and
- 3 regulations to implement the program and to provide:
- 4 (1) Service to passengers of wheelchair-accessible
- 5 <u>taxicabs that is equivalent to the service provided to</u>
- 6 <u>nonwheelchair-accessible taxicab passengers.</u>
- 7 (2) Cost of wheelchair-accessible taxicab service that
- 8 <u>is equivalent to or less than the cost of nonwheelchair-</u>
- 9 <u>accessible taxicab service.</u>
- 10 (3) Vehicle standards for wheelchair-accessible taxicabs
- that allow for the medallion holder to choose any vehicle
- that meets the requirements of the Americans with
- 13 <u>Disabilities Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-336, 104 Stat. 327).</u>
- 14 (4) Training for medallion owners and drivers on
- operating wheelchair-accessible taxicabs and serving
- 16 passengers.
- 17 (5) Outreach regarding wheelchair-accessible taxicab
- 18 service to the physically challenged community and the
- 19 hospitality industry.
- 20 (c) Revocation of certificate. -- The authority may revoke any
- 21 certificate of public convenience granted to any new recipient
- 22 for the operation of a wheelchair-accessible taxicab within a
- 23 city of the first class if the taxicab is not operational within
- 24 120 days of the auction of the medallion.
- 25 (d) Governing law.--Except as provided in this section,
- 26 wheelchair-accessible taxicab certificates and medallions shall
- 27 be governed by the provisions of this chapter.
- 28 (e) Funding.--The Wheelchair-Accessible Taxicab Program
- 29 shall be funded from the Taxicab Account established under
- 30 section 5708 (relating to fund).

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
