## AN ACT

- Amending the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), entitled "An act providing for access to public information, for a 2 designated open-records officer in each Commonwealth agency, 3 local agency, judicial agency and legislative agency, for procedure, for appeal of agency determination, for judicial review and for the Office of Open Records; imposing penalties; providing for reporting by State-related institutions; requiring the posting of certain State contract 8 information on the Internet; and making related repeals," in 9 10 access, further providing for requests. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 12 hereby enacts as follows: 1.3 Section 1. Section 506 of the act of February 14, 2008 14 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-to-Know Law, is amended by 15 adding a subsection to read: 16 Section 506. Requests. 17 18 (e) Inmates. -- An agency may deny a requester access to a 19 record if the requester is an inmate as defined in 61 Pa.C.S. § 20 102 (relating to definitions) or a person incarcerated at a Federal correctional institution. 21
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
