## AN ACT

Amending Titles 23 (Domestic Relations) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, in child custody, further providing for factors to consider when awarding custody; providing for consideration of child abuse and involvement with child protective 3 5 services; in child protective services, further providing for 6 release of information in confidential reports; and in juvenile matters, further providing for inspection of court 8 files and records. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Section 5328(a) of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania 13 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 14 § 5328. Factors to consider when awarding custody. 15 Factors. -- In ordering any form of custody, the court 16 shall determine the best interest of the child by considering 17 all relevant factors, giving weighted consideration to those 18 factors which affect the safety of the child, including the
