Amending Titles 24 (Education) and 71 (State Government) of the

Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for creditable nonschool service, for creditable nonstate service 3 for service performed as a crewleader with the Pennsylvania Conservation Corps and for mandatory and optional membership. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 8304(b) of Title 24 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: § 8304. Creditable nonschool service. 10 11 12 (b) Limitations on nonschool service. -- Creditable nonschool 13 service credit shall be limited to: * * * 14 15 (9) Service as a crewleader prior to July 1, 2011, with 16 the Pennsylvania Conservation Corps, not to exceed a total of 17 five years. In order to elect to purchase the service credit, an active member must file an application with the board no 18 later than three years after the effective date of this 19

- 2 The election of membership in the system shall be irrevocable

- 6 of employment in the case of a newly hired employee. Upon
- 7 receipt of the election, the employer shall certify the election

- 29 (B) military service purchasable under former

2 (C) military service performed during USERRA
3 leave if the member was reemployed from USERRA leave.

- (ii) [the] <u>The</u> total creditable nonstate service under this paragraph may not exceed five years, provided that a member with multiple service may not purchase more than a total of five years of military service in both the system and the Public School Employees' Retirement System[;]
- (3) [in] In the case of an academic administrator, teacher or instructor employed in the Department of Education, the State System of Higher Education, any State-owned educational institution or The Pennsylvania State University, provided that the total amount of service creditable under this paragraph shall not exceed the lesser of ten years or the number of years of active membership in the system as an academic administrator, teacher or instructor in the Department of Education, State System of Higher Education, any State-owned educational institution or The Pennsylvania State University:
 - (i) nonstudent service as an academic administrator,teacher or instructor in any public school or publiceducational institution in any state other than thisCommonwealth; or
 - (ii) nonstudent service as an academic administrator, teacher or instructor in the field of education for any agency or department of the Federal Government, whether or not such area was under the jurisdiction of the United States[;].
 - (4) [previous] <u>Previous</u> service with a governmental

- agency other than the Commonwealth which employment with said agency was terminated because of the transfer by statute of the administration of such service or of the entire agency to the Commonwealth[;].
 - (5) [service] <u>Service</u> as a temporary Federal employee assigned to an air quality control complement for the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources at any time during the period of 1970 through 1975. This service time may be purchased only if the member makes an election to purchase within one year of the effective date of this paragraph, and the member shall pay an amount which is equal to the full actuarial cost of the increased benefit obtained by virtue of the purchase as provided in section 5505(f)[;].
 - (6) [service] <u>Service</u> in the Cadet Nurse Corps with respect to any period of training as a student or graduate nurse under a plan approved under section 2 of the act of June 15, 1943 (Public Law 78-73, 57 Stat. 153), if the total period of training under such plan was at least two years, the credit for such service not to exceed three years[;].
 - (7) [service] <u>Service</u> prior to July 1, 1971, at a community college established under the act of August 24, 1963 (P.L.1132, No.484), known as the Community College Act of 1963[; or].
