## AN ACT

14	hereby enacts as follows:
15	Section 1. Section 303(a) of the act of June 28, 1995
16	(P.L.89, No.18), known as the Conservation and Natural Resources
17	Act, is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
18	Section 303. Parks.
19	(a) Powers and duties enumeratedThe department shall have
20	the following powers and duties with respect to parks:
21	* * *

1	(7.1) To provide park rangers required to receive
2	training under 53 Pa.C.S. Ch. 21 Subch. D (relating to
3	municipal police education and training) and carry a firearm
4	in fulfillment of their duties with the option of also
5	carrying a department-issued electronic incapacitation
6	device. The department shall provide an electronic
7	incapacitation device training program, conducted by a
8	certified instructor, to any park ranger opting to carry a
9	department-issued electronic incapacitation device.

11	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
