AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, providing for Senior Resident Annual Fishing
- 3 License reciprocity.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 30 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 2702.2. Senior Resident Annual Fishing License reciprocity.
- 9 (a) Permission. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 10 title, any person who possesses a valid and lawfully issued
- 11 <u>Senior Resident Annual Fishing License or permit which has been</u>
- 12 issued under the laws of another state, regardless of whether a
- 13 reciprocity agreement exists between the Commonwealth and the
- 14 state under subsection (b), may fish in any of the waters of
- 15 this Commonwealth or in any boundary waters if all of the
- 16 <u>following apply:</u>
- 17 <u>(1) The state provides a reciprocal privilege for</u>

- 1 <u>individuals possessing a Senior Resident Annual Fishing</u>
- 2 License issued under section 2701(b) (relating to resident
- 3 <u>fishing licenses</u>).
- 4 (2) The Attorney General has determined that the fishing
- 5 <u>laws of the state are similar to the fishing laws of this</u>
- 6 <u>Commonwealth.</u>
- 7 (b) Reciprocity. -- The following shall apply:
- 8 (1) The Attorney General shall have the power and duty
- 9 <u>to enter into reciprocity agreements with other states</u>
- 10 providing for the mutual recognition of Senior Resident
- 11 Annual Fishing Licenses issued by the Commonwealth and a
- 12 <u>similar license or permit issued by the other state. To carry</u>
- out this duty, the Attorney General is authorized to
- 14 <u>negotiate reciprocity agreements and grant recognition of a</u>
- 15 <u>Senior Resident Annual Fishing License or permit issued by</u>
- 16 <u>another state.</u>
- 17 (2) The Attorney General shall report to the General
- 18 Assembly within 180 days of the effective date of this
- 19 paragraph and annually thereafter concerning the agreements
- 20 which have been consummated under this subsection.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
