AN ACT

1 2	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for definitions.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. The definition of "emergency service responder"
6	in section 102 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph and the section is
8	amended by adding definitions to read:
9	§ 102. Definitions.
10	Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
11	provisions of this title which are applicable to specific
12	provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when
13	used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly
14	indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:

2	"Electric cooperative personnel." Individuals who:
3	(1) work as employees or contractors of an electric
4	<u>cooperative;</u>
5	(2) provide disaster emergency-related services,
6	including repair, renovation, installation, construction and
7	activities related to damaged, impaired or destroyed
8	infrastructure; and
9	(3) perform services under paragraph (2) within the
10	first 72 hours after a declared emergency or until the
11	expiration of a declared emergency, whichever is later.

13	"Electric utility personnel." Individuals who:
14	(1) work as employees or contractors of an electric
15	utility;
16	(2) provide disaster emergency-related services,
17	including repair, renovation, installation, construction and
18	activities related to damaged, impaired or destroyed
19	infrastructure; and
20	(3) perform services under paragraph (2) within the
21	first 72 hours after a declared emergency or until the
22	expiration of a declared emergency, whichever is later.

24	"Emergency service responder." An individual acting in an
25	official capacity as any of the following:

27	(14) Electric cooperative personnel and electric utility
28	personnel.

30	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
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
