AN ACT

Providing for the establishment of a searchable budget database <-driven Internet website detailing certain information concerning taxpayer expenditures and investments by school districts. PROVIDING FOR THE POSTING OF ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORTS FOR PUBLIC <--SCHOOL ENTITIES, FOR THE CONVENING OF AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE, 7 FOR POSTING OF FINAL ADOPTED BUDGETS FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL ENTITIES AND FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION'S ESTABLISHMENT 8 OF A SEARCHABLE INTERNET WEBSITE DETAILING CERTAIN 9 INFORMATION CONCERNING RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES BY PUBLIC 10 SCHOOL ENTITIES. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Short title. 14 <--15 This act shall be known and may be cited as the School-16 District Web Accountability and Transparency (SchoolWATCH) Act. Section 2. Definitions. 18 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 19 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 20 context clearly indicates otherwise:

"Department." The Department of Education of the 1 2 Commonwealth. "Entity." Any of the following: 3 (1) An individual, corporation, association, union, 4 5 limited liability company or limited liability partnership. (2) Any other legal business entity, including a 6 7 nonprofit, a grantee, a contractor and a sole proprietor. 8 (3) Any political subdivision or other local government 9 entity. 10 "Funding action or expenditure." A payment by a schooldistrict to include: 11 12 (1) A grant. 13 (2) A loan. 14 (3) Reimbursement. 15 (4) Payment made pursuant to the purchase of goods and 16 services, including employee salaries, or to a constructionor other contract. 17 18 (5) Payment of debt service. 19 (6) Payments made pursuant to a formula. 20 (7) Payments to political subdivisions or other local 21 government entities. "Funding source." A school district's general fund or 22 23 special funds. "Public School Code of 1949." The act of March 10, 1949 24 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949. 25 "School district." As defined in section 102 of the act of 26 March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code 27 of 1949. 28 Section 3. Searchable database. 29 30 (a) Development. By December 31, 2014, the department shall

1	develop, implement and maintain a single, searchable, public
2	Internet website to be called SchoolWATCH.
3	(b) Internet website contents. The Internet website
4	required pursuant to subsection (a) shall provide the following-
5	information for each school district:
6	(1) The name and address of the school district.
7	(2) The amount of funding received by the school
8	district from Federal, State, local and private sources and
9	deposited in the school district's general fund or special
10	fund during the previous month.
11	(3) The name and address of the entity receiving a
12	payment from the school district pursuant to a funding action
13	or expenditure.
14	(4) A description and the amount of each funding action
15	or expenditure.
16	(5) The funding source for each funding action or
17	expenditure.
18	(6) The expected and achieved performance outcomes from
19	the funding action or expenditure, if available.
20	(7) A counter to show the number of times the Internet
21	website is accessed.
22	(8) A link to each school district's Internet website,
23	where available.
24	(9) The total number of individuals employed by each
25	school district as of the 15th day of the previous month.
26	(10) For each individual employed by a school district,
27	the following:
28	(i) Name.
29	(ii) Position or title.
30	(iii) Current annual salary, based on the employee's

Τ	pay schedule and current salary.
2	(iv) Any additional compensation received by the
3	individual and the basis for such compensation,
4	including, but not limited to, duties as a coach or
5	activity advisor.
6	(v) Compensation, as defined in section 303(a)(1)(i)
7	of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the
8	Tax Reform Code of 1971, paid by the school district.
9	(c) Exemption. Notwithstanding any other provision of this
10	act, records not subject to disclosure under the act of February
11	14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right to Know Law, shall
12	not be included on the Internet website.
13	(d) Access The Internet website shall allow the public to-
14	search for and aggregate information at no cost.
15	(e) Maintenance. Information for a fiscal year shall remain
16	on the Internet website for a period of no less than eight years
17	from the date of posting.
18	Section 4. Administration.
19	(a) School district requirements Each school district
20	shall cooperate with the department. The following shall apply:
21	(1) Each school district shall provide the department
22	with all information regarding Federal, State, local and
23	private funding received and all funding actions or
24	expenditures as required under this act at the time the
25	funding is received or the funding action or expenditure is
26	paid by the school district.
27	(2) Each school district shall provide the department
28	with complement and employment compensation information as
29	required under this act prior to the end of each month.
30	(b) Accuracy. Each school district is responsible for

- 1 verifying the accuracy and completeness of information submitted-
- 2 to the department.
- 3 (c) Format. Each school district shall establish and
- 4 maintain the information required to be posted under section 3
- 5 in a manner prescribed by the department. The department shall
- 6 consult with school districts to develop the format to be-
- 7 utilized.
- 8 (d) Penalty. A school district that fails to comply with
- 9 the provisions of this act shall be subject to withholding of
- 10 State appropriations pursuant to section 2552 of the Public-
- 11 School Code of 1949.
- 12 Section 5. Report to Governor and General Assembly.
- 13 The department shall prepare an annual report containing
- 14 statistical information on the usage and performance of the
- 15 Internet website. The report shall contain frequency of user-
- 16 access of the Internet website, types of data being accessed and
- 17 Internet website performance. The report shall be submitted to-
- 18 the Governor, the chairman and minority chairman of the
- 19 Appropriations Committee of the Senate, the chairman and
- 20 minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the House
- 21 of Representatives, the chairman and minority chairman of the
- 22 Education Committee of the Senate and the chairman and minority
- 23 chairman of the Education Committee of the House of
- 24 Representatives by March 30 of each year, beginning March 30,
- 25 2016.
- 26 Section 6. Effective date.
- 27 This act shall take effect immediately.

- 11 "FUNDING SOURCE." A PUBLIC SCHOOL ENTITY'S GENERAL FUND OR

- 30 "SECRETARY." THE SECRETARY OF EDUCATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

- 1 SECTION 3. ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORTS TO BE POSTED.
- 2 WITHIN 90 DAYS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT, AND BY
- 3 DECEMBER 31 OF EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL POST
- 4 ON ITS PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE, AS THE FIRST PHASE
- 5 OF A SINGLE, SEARCHABLE, PUBLIC INTERNET WEBSITE TO BE CALLED
- 6 SCHOOLWATCH, THE MOST RECENT ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORTS FOR EACH
- 7 PUBLIC SCHOOL ENTITY SUBMITTED TO THE SECRETARY PURSUANT TO
- 8 SECTION 218(A) OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CODE OF 1949. THE DEPARTMENT
- 9 SHALL POST SCHOOLWATCH IN A LOCATION AND IN A MANNER THAT IS
- 10 EASILY ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC AND SHALL INCLUDE ON SCHOOLWATCH
- 11 ALL EXPLANATORY REFERENCES THAT MAY BE NECESSARY TO ASSIST
- 12 WEBSITE USERS IN UNDERSTANDING THE CONTENT OF PUBLIC SCHOOL
- 13 ENTITIES' ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORTS.
- 14 SECTION 4. ANNUAL BUDGETS TO BE POSTED.
- 15 (A) FILING.--WITHIN 11 MONTHS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS
- 16 ACT, AND BY SEPTEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, EACH PUBLIC
- 17 SCHOOL ENTITY SHALL FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT AN ELECTRONIC COPY
- 18 OF ITS MOST RECENT FINAL ADOPTED BUDGET.
- 19 (B) POSTING.--WITHIN ONE YEAR OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS
- 20 ACT, AND BY OCTOBER 1 OF EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT
- 21 SHALL POST ON SCHOOLWATCH, AS THE SECOND PHASE OF SCHOOLWATCH,
- 22 THE FINAL ADOPTED BUDGETS FOR EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL ENTITY FILED
- 23 WITH THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (A) AND SHALL INCLUDE
- 24 ON SCHOOLWATCH ALL EXPLANATORY REFERENCES THAT MAY BE NECESSARY
- 25 TO ASSIST WEBSITE USERS IN UNDERSTANDING THE CONTENT OF PUBLIC
- 26 SCHOOL ENTITIES' FINAL ADOPTED BUDGETS.

- (1) WITHIN 45 DAYS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT,
- THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONVENE AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO DEVELOP

1	A PLAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT'S ESTABLISHMENT OF THE THIRD PHASE

- 8 (A) PUBLIC SCHOOL ENTITY REQUIREMENTS.--
- 9 (1) UPON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SCHOOLWATCH INTERNET
 10 WEBSITE REQUIRED TO BE DEVELOPED PURSUANT TO THIS ACT, EACH
