## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), entitled, as <-amended, "An act to promote the public health and safety by 3 providing for examination, licensing and granting of permits for those who desire to engage in the profession of cosmetology; defining cosmetology, and regulating cosmetology salons, schools, students, apprentices, teachers, managers, manicurists and cosmetologists; conferring powers and duties 7 8 upon the Commissioner of Professional and Occupational Affairs in the Department of State; providing for appeals to certain courts by applicants and licensees; and providing 10 penalties," providing for authorization of school of-11 12 cosmetology as institution-PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION OF CERTAIN SCHOOLS AS INSTITUTIONS 13 of postsecondary education. 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 16 hereby enacts as follows: 17 Section 1. The act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), referred <--18 to as the Cosmetology Law, is amended by adding a section to 19 read: 20 Section 6.1. Authorization of School of Cosmetology as 21 Institution of Postsecondary Education. A school of cosmetology

- 1 shall be recognized and authorized as an institution of
- 2 postsecondary education if it meets the following conditions:
- 3 (1) The school admits as regular students only those
- 4 <u>individuals who are either beyond the age of compulsory</u>
- 5 education or have a high school diploma or a diploma based on
- 6 passing general educational development (GED) tests or their
- 7 <u>equivalent.</u>
- 8 (2) The school is licensed by name and authorized by the
- 9 Department of State and the board under this act to offer one or

- 10 more training programs beyond the secondary level.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
- 12 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 13 THIS ACT SHALL BE KNOWN AND MAY BE CITED AS THE HIGHER
- 14 EDUCATION ELIGIBILITY ACT.
- 15 SECTION 2. RECOGNITION.
- 16 FOR PURPOSES OF ESTABLISHING INSTITUTIONAL ELIGIBILITY UNDER
- 17 TITLE IV OF THE HIGHER EDUCATION ACT OF 1965 (PUBLIC LAW 89-329,
- 18 79 STAT. 1232), THE SCHOOLS ENUMERATED IN SECTION 3 ARE
- 19 RECOGNIZED BY NAME AS EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS BY THE
- 20 COMMONWEALTH AND AUTHORIZED TO OPERATE AS EDUCATIONAL
- 21 INSTITUTIONS IN THIS COMMONWEALTH IF THEY SATISFY THE FOLLOWING
- 22 CONDITIONS:
- 23 (1) THE SCHOOL ADMITS AS REGULAR STUDENTS ONLY THOSE
- 24 INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE ELIGIBLE BEYOND THE AGE OF COMPULSORY
- 25 EDUCATION OR HAVE A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR A DIPLOMA BASED ON
- 26 PASSING GENERAL EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT TESTS OR AN
- 27 EQUIVALENT TEST.
- 28 (2) THE SCHOOL IS LICENSED BY NAME AND AUTHORIZED BY A
- 29 STATE LICENSING BOARD, THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE OR THE STATE
- 30 BOARD OF EDUCATION, UNDER STATE LAW TO OFFER AT LEAST ONE

- 1 TRAINING PROGRAM BEYOND THE SECONDARY LEVEL.
- 2 SECTION 3. SCHOOLS.
- 3 THE FOLLOWING SCHOOLS ARE INCLUDED UNDER SECTION 2:
- 4 (1) A LICENSED BARBER SCHOOL UNDER THE ACT OF JUNE 19,
- 5 1931 (P.L.589, NO.202), REFERRED TO AS THE BARBERS' LICENSE
- 6 LAW.
- 7 (2) A SCHOOL OF COSMETOLOGY AS DEFINED BY SECTION 1 OF
- 8 THE ACT OF MAY 3, 1933 (P.L.242, NO.86), REFERRED TO AS THE
- 9 COSMETOLOGY LAW.
- 10 (3) A SCHOOL WHICH PROVIDES AN APPROVED PROGRAM OF
- PROFESSIONAL NURSING UNDER THE ACT OF MAY 22, 1951 (P.L.317,
- 12 NO.69), KNOWN AS THE PROFESSIONAL NURSING LAW.
- 13 (4) A REGIONALLY ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY
- 14 APPROVED UNDER SECTION 6(B)(2) AND (3) OF THE PROFESSIONAL
- 15 NURSING LAW FOR EDUCATION AS A DIETITIAN-NUTRITIONIST.
- 16 SECTION 20. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 17 THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
