## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, providing for establishment of advisory committee; and imposing a moratorium on implementation of Common Core Standards.. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 12 section to read: Section 123. Establishment of Advisory Committee and

- Imposition of Moratorium on Implementation of Common Core 14
- 15 Standards.--(a) An advisory committee is established to review
- research and data that supports and rejects the use of Common 16
- 17 Core Standards for education in this Commonwealth.
- 18 (b) The advisory committee shall consist of the following:
- 19 (1) One person appointed by the Governor.
- (2) Three members of the Education Committee of the Senate, 2.0

- 1 two of whom shall be appointed by the majority chairman of that
- 2 committee and one of whom shall be appointed by the minority
- 3 chairman of that committee.
- 4 (3) Three members of the Education Committee of the House of
- 5 Representatives, two of whom shall be appointed by the majority
- 6 chairman of that committee and one of whom shall be appointed by
- 7 the minority chairman of that committee.
- 8 (c) The members of the advisory committee shall receive no
- 9 <u>remuneration for serving on the advisory committee, but shall be</u>
- 10 entitled to reimbursement for reasonable expenses incurred by
- 11 them in the performance of their duties on the advisory
- 12 <u>committee.</u>
- 13 <u>(d) The advisory committee shall hold at least two public</u>
- 14 meetings and shall submit, no later than November 1, 2014, a
- 15 written report of the advisory committee's findings and
- 16 <u>recommendations to the majority and minority chairmen of the</u>
- 17 Education Committees of the Senate and of the House of
- 18 <u>Representatives.</u>
- 19 (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act or other
- 20 law to the contrary, no Common Core Standards may be implemented
- 21 in this Commonwealth until 90 days after the submission of the
- 22 report required under subsection (d).
- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
