AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in grounds and buildings, further providing for limitation on new applications for Department of Education approval of public school building projects; 5 7 establishing Building Blocks PA and the Public School Facilities Financing Commission; and providing for the powers and duties of the commission. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 732.1(a) of the act of March 10, 1949 14 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, 15 amended July 9, 2013 (P.L.408, No.59), is amended to read: 16 Section 732.1. Limitation on New Applications for Department 17 of Education Approval of Public School Building Projects. -- (a) 18 For the 2012-2013 fiscal year [and the 2013-2014 fiscal year], 19 the Department of Education shall not accept or approve new 20 school building construction or reconstruction project applications. Completed school building construction or 21

- 1 reconstruction project applications received by the Department
- 2 of Education by October 1, 2012, are not subject to this
- 3 provision.

- 5 Section 2. The act is amended by adding an article to read:
- 6 ARTICLE VII-A
- 7 <u>BUILDING BLOCKS PA</u>
- 8 <u>Section 701-A. Definitions.</u>
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this article
- 10 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 12 "Building Blocks PA." The program through which the
- 13 department approves and provides for Commonwealth reimbursement
- 14 of school construction projects, formerly known as PlanCon.
- 15 "Commission." The Public School Facilities Financing
- 16 <u>Commission established by this article.</u>
- 17 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 18 <u>Commonwealth</u>.
- 19 "PlanCon." The department's Planning and Construction
- 20 Workbook.
- 21 <u>Section 702-A. Establishment.</u>
- 22 A program to be known as Building Blocks PA is established in
- 23 the department.
- 24 <u>Section 703-A. Powers and duties of the department.</u>
- The department shall have the following powers and duties
- 26 with regard to Building Blocks PA:
- 27 (1) To set educational and construction standards
- 28 <u>applicable to a building project to determine whether the</u>
- 29 <u>project is eligible for reimbursement.</u>
- 30 (2) To limit the frequency of an application for school

- 1 construction reimbursement based on the amount of time since
- 2 a building was constructed or the time since the bid opening
- 3 <u>date of the previous reimbursable project, provided that a</u>
- 4 <u>school building construction or reconstruction project</u>
- 5 <u>application for any of the following purposes shall not be</u>
- 6 <u>subject to frequency limitations:</u>
- 7 <u>(i) A technological improvement project.</u>
- 8 <u>(ii) A school health and safety improvement project.</u>
- 9 <u>(iii) An emergency repair as a result of storm-</u>
- related damage or other damage related to an act of God.
- 11 <u>(iv) An energy efficiency improvement project.</u>
- 12 <u>(v) A project to attain certification under the</u>
- 13 <u>United States Green Building Council's Leadership in</u>
- 14 <u>Energy and Environmental Design Green Building Rating</u>
- 15 <u>System or the Green Building Initiative's Green Globes</u>
- 16 <u>Green Building Rating System.</u>
- 17 (3) To consider requests for variances from any
- 18 frequency or valuation limitations to allow for the
- 19 <u>reimbursement of alteration or renovation costs for a</u>
- 20 building or project.
- 21 Section 704-A. Wages.
- 22 <u>A new school building construction or reconstruction project</u>
- 23 approved by the department for reimbursement under this article
- 24 shall comply with the provisions of the act of August 15, 1961
- 25 (P.L.987, No.442), known as the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage
- 26 Act.
- 27 Section 705-A. Applications.
- For the 2014-2015 fiscal year and thereafter, a new school
- 29 <u>building construction or reconstruction project application</u>
- 30 <u>shall include documentation that each contractor or firm</u>

- 1 performing work participates in an active apprenticeship program
- 2 which is currently registered with and approved by the United
- 3 States Department of Labor or the Pennsylvania Apprenticeship
- 4 and Training Council for each separate trade or classification
- 5 for which it is performing work on that project and which has an
- 6 apprentice currently registered or graduated within the previous
- 7 <u>12 months.</u>
- 8 <u>Section 706-A. Financing.</u>
- 9 <u>School construction reimbursements shall be calculated and</u>
- 10 <u>distributed under Article XXV</u>. The total amount of
- 11 <u>reimbursements awarded shall be limited to funds appropriated</u>
- 12 for this purpose. Applications for reimbursement shall be filed
- 13 <u>in accordance with procedures developed by the department.</u>
- 14 <u>Section 707-A. Public School Facilities Financing Commission.</u>
- 15 (a) Establishment. -- The Public School Facilities Financing
- 16 <u>Commission is established and shall review and make</u>
- 17 recommendations related to public school facilities' financing
- 18 <u>as provided in this section.</u>
- 19 (b) Membership.--
- 20 (1) The commission shall consist of the following
- 21 members:
- 22 <u>(i) The chair and minority chair of the Education</u>
- 23 <u>Committee of the Senate and the chair and minority chair</u>
- of the Education Committee of the House of
- 25 <u>Representatives, or their designees.</u>
- 26 (ii) Two legislators from each of the four
- legislative caucuses, to be appointed by the President
- 28 pro tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
- 29 Representatives, in consultation with the Majority and
- 30 Minority Leaders of the Senate and the Majority and

1	Minority Leaders of the House of Representatives.
2	(iii) The Secretary of Education, or a designee.
3	(iv) The Executive Director of the State Public
4	School Building Authority, or a designee.
5	(v) The State Treasurer, or a designee.
6	(2) The commission shall appoint a member to serve as
7	chair of the commission.
8	(c) Meetings
9	(1) The commission shall hold its first meeting within
10	30 days of the effective date of this section, regardless of
11	whether the Governor or all legislative caucuses have
12	actually approved members to the commission.
13	(2) The commission shall hold meetings at the call of
14	the chair.
15	(3) All meetings and public hearings of the commission
16	shall be deemed public meetings for the purpose of 65 Pa.C.S.
17	Ch. 7 (relating to open meetings).
18	(4) A majority of the members of the commission shall
19	constitute a quorum. If fewer than a majority are present at
20	any meeting, no business shall be transacted at the meeting.
21	(d) Reimbursement of expenses The members may not receive
22	compensation for their services, but shall be reimbursed for all
23	necessary travel and other reasonable expenses incurred in
24	connection with the performance of their duties as members of
25	the commission.
26	(e) Administration The General Assembly shall provide
27	administrative support, meeting space and any other assistance
28	required by the commission to carry out its duties under this
29	section in cooperation with the department. The department shall
30	provide the commission with data, research and other information

Τ.	apon request by the commission.
2	(f) Powers and duties The commission shall have the
3	following powers and duties:
4	(1) Consult with and utilize experts to assist in
5	carrying out the duties under this subsection.
6	(2) Hold public hearings in different regions of this
7	Commonwealth.
8	(3) Review and make findings and recommendations related
9	to funding public school facilities in this Commonwealth, to
10	include all of the following:
11	(i) Analysis of the preliminary study under section
12	732.1(b).
13	(ii) The impact of and financing considerations
14	relating to green building, energy efficiency, school
15	safety and technological improvement projects.
16	(iii) Historical trends in funding public school
17	facilities in this Commonwealth.
18	(iv) The capacity of Building Blocks PA to meet
19	existing capital needs.
20	(v) The ability of Building Blocks PA to meet
21	anticipated future capital needs.
22	(vi) Other financial vehicles to meet current and
23	future capital needs, including, but not limited to,
24	bonds.
25	(vii) The role of the State Public School Building
26	Authority and Pennsylvania Higher Educational Facilities
27	Authority in funding school facilities to include
28	recommendations relating to restructuring or expanding
29	the duties of these entities.
30	(4) Review and consider methods used in other states to

- 1 <u>finance public school facilities.</u>
- 2 (5) Issue a report of its findings and recommendations
- 3 to the Governor, the President pro tempore of the Senate, the
- 4 <u>Majority Leader and Minority Leader of the Senate, the</u>
- 5 <u>Education Committee of the Senate, the Speaker of the House</u>
- 6 of Representatives, the Majority Leader and Minority Leader
- 7 of the House of Representatives, the Education Committee of
- 8 the House of Representatives, the Secretary of Education and
- 9 the State Public School Building Authority within 120 days of
- the first meeting or September 30, 2014, whichever is later.
- 11 (g) Continuation of commission. -- Every ten years the
- 12 <u>commission shall be reconstituted in accordance with subsection</u>
- 13 (c), shall meet and hold public hearings to review the
- 14 provisions of this section and shall issue a report to the
- 15 recipients listed in subsection (f)(5).
- 16 Section 708-A. Regulations.
- 17 The Secretary of Education shall propose regulations for
- 18 promulgation by the State Board of Education to implement the
- 19 provisions of this article.
- 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
