2.2	"Renewal" or "to renew." To issue and deliver at the end of

1 an insurance policy period a policy which supersedes a policy previously issued and delivered by the same insurer or 2 affiliated insurer and which provides types and limits of 3 coverage at least equal to those contained in the policy being 4 superseded, or to issue and deliver a certificate or notice 5 extending the term of a policy beyond its policy period or term 6 with types and limits of coverage at least equal to those 7 8 contained in the policy being extended: Provided, however, That any policy with a policy period or term of less than twelve (12) 9 10 months or any period with no fixed expiration date shall for the purpose of this article be considered as if written for 11 successive policy periods or terms of twelve (12) months. 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 13
