AN ACT

- 1 Providing for suicide prevention continuing education.
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 hereby enacts as follows:
- 4 Section 1. Short title.
- 5 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Matt Adler
- 6 Suicide Prevention Continuing Education Act.
- 7 Section 2. Definitions.
- 8 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 9 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 10 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Licensing board." The State Board of Psychology and the
- 12 State Board of Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapists
- 13 and Professional Counselors.
- 14 Section 3. Continuing education requirement.

- 1 A licensing board shall provide that a licensee complete at
- 2 least one hour of continuing education in the assessment,
- 3 treatment and management of suicide risks as a portion of the
- 4 total continuing education required for license renewal.
- 5 Section 4. Regulations.
- A licensing board under section 3 shall promulgate
- 7 regulations necessary to effectuate this act no later than 18
- 8 months from the effective date of this act.
- 9 Section 5. Effective date.
- 10 This act shall take effect immediately.
