- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The title and section 1 of the act of June 26,

- 2 Callaghan Memorial Highway.
- 3 Section 1. Officers Luke Arlington Conner and [John] J. Horace
- 4 Callaghan Memorial Highway.
- 5 (a) Findings.--
- 6 (1) Officer Luke Arlington Conner.
- 7 (i) Officer Conner was a resident of Prospect Park
- 8 and an officer of the Prospect Park Police Department for
- 9 two years.
- 10 (ii) On October 8, 1919, Officer Conner was on foot
- 11 patrol on U.S. Route 13, also known as the Chester Pike,
- 12 and was struck by a vehicle, dying six hours later in a
- 13 local hospital.
- 14 (iii) Officer Conner was survived by his wife and
- 15 five children.
- 16 (2) Officer [John] <u>J.</u> Horace Callaghan.
- 17 (i) Officer Callaghan was a resident of Prospect
- 18 Park and an officer of the Prospect Park Police
- 19 Department for 15 years.
- 20 (ii) On December 21, 1940, Officer Callaghan was
- 21 directing traffic on U.S. Route 13, also known as the
- 22 Chester Pike, near Stewart Avenue, when he was struck by
- 23 a drunk driver.
- 24 (iii) Officer Callaghan was survived by his wife and
- 25 three children.
- 26 (b) Designation. -- The 700 to 800 block of U.S. Route 13,
- 27 also known as the Chester Pike, in Prospect Park Borough,
- 28 Delaware County, is designated as the Officers Luke Arlington
- 29 Conner and [John] J. Horace Callaghan Memorial Highway.
- 30 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and

- 1 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
- 2 traffic in both directions on the highway.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
