## A RESOLUTION

4	WHEREAS, There are 1,124 municipal police departments serving
5	the citizens of this Commonwealth; and
6	WHEREAS, This Commonwealth currently faces a period of fiscal
7	concern that requires each <del>department of State government</del> LEVEL <
8	OF GOVERNMENT IN THIS COMMONWEALTH to consider avenues of
9	potential reduction in costs and expenditures; and
10	WHEREAS, One potential way to reduce costs while continuing
11	to ensure public safety is to consolidate or merge municipal
12	police departments; therefore be it
13	RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the
14	Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to conduct a study
15	concerning the consolidation OR MERGER of municipal police <
16	departments in this Commonwealth; and be it further
17	RESOLVED, That the study include an analysis of the funding

1 of municipal police departments and provide recommendations
2 necessary to improve the manner in which the funding is <-3 allocated to the municipal police departments ARE FUNDED <-4 throughout this Commonwealth; and be it further</pre>

5 RESOLVED, THAT THE STUDY INCLUDE AN EXPLORATION OF ADDITIONAL <--</li>
6 WAYS IN WHICH MUNICIPALITIES CAN DETERMINE AND SHARE THE COSTS
7 OF POLICE SERVICES, SUCH AS PURCHASING SERVICES IN THIS
8 COMMONWEALTH; AND BE IT FURTHER

9 RESOLVED, THAT THE STUDY INCLUDE AN ANALYSIS OF ANY POTENTIAL 10 SAVINGS THAT MAY RESULT FROM THE CONSOLIDATION OR MERGER OF 11 MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENTS OR OTHERWISE SHARING POLICE 12 SERVICES, SUCH AS PURCHASING SERVICES IN THIS COMMONWEALTH; AND 13 BE IT FURTHER

14 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee 15 provide recommendations concerning the SUGGESTED GUIDELINES TO <--16 ASSIST MUNICIPALITIES WITH A MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENT TO 17 IDENTIFY THOSE municipal police departments best suited for 18 consolidation or merger; and be it further

19 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee 20 submit the report to the chairman and minority chairman of the <--21 Judiciary Committee of the House of Representatives by December-30, 2013. PREPARE A REPORT WITH ITS ANALYSIS AND RECOMMENDATIONS <--22 23 AND TRANSMIT A COPY OF THE REPORT TO THE CHAIRMAN, MINORITY 24 CHAIRMAN AND ALL MEMBERS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMMITTEE OF 25 THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES WITHIN ONE YEAR OF THE ADOPTION OF 26 THIS RESOLUTION.

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
