A RESOLUTION

- 1 Establishing a select committee for the purpose of recommending draft language on a transportation funding bill.
- 3 WHEREAS, A well-designed transportation infrastructure is
- 4 crucial to the economic vitality and well-being of the citizens
- 5 of this Commonwealth; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The General Assembly has been unable to adopt a plan
- 7 to replace lost revenue dedicated to transportation since April
- 8 6, 2010, when the United States Department of Transportation
- 9 denied Pennsylvania's ability to toll Interstate 80 pursuant to
- 10 its application in accordance with Act 44 of 2007; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The need for additional funding for transportation
- 12 has been well established by various studies and continues to
- 13 grow; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The Governor has asked the General Assembly for a
- 15 comprehensive transportation funding bill; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The Senate is restricted by section 10 of Article
- 17 III of the Constitution of Pennsylvania from introducing any
- 18 bill to raise revenue, thus preventing the House of

- 1 Representatives from voting on Senate Bill No.1 (2013); and
- 2 WHEREAS, There are several and conflicting House bills that
- 3 deal with transportation funding; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The best comprehensive transportation funding bill
- 5 would be one that would be linked to an overall transportation
- 6 policy; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The task of drafting a comprehensive transportation
- 8 funding bill is inherently more complicated than generally
- 9 recognized, requiring expertise in transportation, finance,
- 10 appropriations and regional planning; and
- 11 WHEREAS, For all these reasons, it is imperative to expedite
- 12 the process; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives establish a
- 14 select committee to make a recommendation to the House of
- 15 Representatives on a comprehensive transportation funding plan,
- 16 including presenting draft language that can be introduced as a
- 17 bill; and be it further
- 18 RESOLVED, That the select committee consist of the following
- 19 members of the House of Representatives:
- 20 (1) the chairman of the Transportation Committee;
- 21 (2) the minority chairman of the Transportation Committee;
- 22 (3) the chairman of the Finance Committee;
- 23 (4) the minority chairman of the Finance Committee;
- 24 (5) the chairman of the Appropriations Committee;
- 25 (6) the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee;
- 26 (7) one additional member appointed by the Speaker;
- 27 (8) one additional member appointed by the Majority Leader;
- 28 (9) one additional member appointed by the Minority Leader;
- 29 and be it further
- 30 RESOLVED, That the Speaker of the House of Representatives

- 1 establish the first meeting time and place of the select
- 2 committee to be within 24 hours of the adoption of this
- 3 resolution; and be it further
- 4 RESOLVED, That the select committee on its first meeting
- 5 select a chairman; and be it further
- 6 RESOLVED, That the Majority Leader and Minority Leader of the
- 7 House of Representatives provide staffing and assistance to the
- 8 select committee, including obtaining relevant data and other
- 9 research; and be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, That the ordinary and reasonable expenses incurred
- 11 by the select committee be paid from accounts under the control
- 12 of the Chief Clerk; and be it further
- 13 RESOLVED, That the select committee present its final
- 14 recommendation and draft language by October 31, 2013.
