## AN ACT

The act is amended by adding sections to read: 19 Section 1626.2. Monthly Reporting. -- Any political committee or candidate who receives contributions in an aggregate amount 20 of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) in a calendar month or\_ 21 22 incurs expenditures of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) in a calendar month shall file a report within thirty (30) days of 23 the last day of that month with the Secretary of the 24 25 Commonwealth. 26 Section 1631.1. Manner of Filing.--All Statewide candidates 27 and candidates for Senator or Representative in the General Assembly shall file all their reports electronically with the 28 Secretary of the Commonwealth. 29 30 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
