AN ACT

1 Prohibiting bonuses for employees of Commonwealth agencies.

2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

3 hereby enacts as follows:

4 Section 1. Short title.

5 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Commonwealth6 Agency Bonus Ban Act.

7 Section 2. Definitions.

8 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 9 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 10 context clearly indicates otherwise:

"Bonus." Any monetary compensation given to an employee above and beyond the employee's annual salary or other rate of pay. The term does not include the following:

14 (1) Reimbursement or payments for expenses related to
15 official business, including meals, housing, uniforms, car
16 allowance and other expenses.

(2) Severance payments pursuant to a personnel
 compensation plan, contract or collective bargaining
 agreement.

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(3) Payments for unused vacation or sick leave.

5 (4) An annual cost-of-living adjustment equivalency 6 payment made to an individual, at the maximum of a salary 7 range, adopted pursuant to a personnel compensation plan or a 8 collective bargaining agreement.

9 (5) An arbitration award.

10 (6) Payments made pursuant to litigation.

11 (7) Overtime payments required for work performed in 12 excess of the maximum workweek.

13 (8) Shift differential payments, standby or call-time
14 payments or extra duty payments made pursuant to a collective
15 bargaining agreement.

16 A personnel compensation plan, contract or collective bargaining 17 agreement under this definition shall be in writing and shall be 18 open for public inspection.

19 "Commonwealth agency." Any of the following:

(1) The Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General,
Auditor General, State Treasurer and the departments,
offices, boards, authorities, commissions and other agencies
of the executive branch of the government of this
Commonwealth, whether or not subject to the supervision and
control of the Governor.

26 (2) The legislative branch of the government of this27 Commonwealth.

(3) Any court and any office of the unified judicialsystem of this Commonwealth.

30 Section 3. Bonus ban.

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No Commonwealth agency may pay a bonus to any of its
 employees.

3 Section 4. Penalties.

4 (a) Reimbursement.--Employees of Commonwealth agencies who
5 are paid a bonus after the effective date of this section shall
6 reimburse their employer for the full amount of the bonus.

7 (b) Penalty.--An individual who intentionally approves or 8 authorizes a bonus prohibited by this act commits a misdemeanor 9 of the third degree.

(c) Effect on compensation. -- A bonus payment made in 10 violation of section 3 as determined by the Commonwealth agency 11 12 or by a court of competent jurisdiction shall not be deemed to be compensation under 71 Pa.C.S. Pt. XXV (relating to retirement 13 14 for State employees and officers). This act shall not affect the definition of "compensation" under 71 Pa.C.S. Pt. XXV or 24 15 Pa.C.S. Pt. IV (relating to retirement for school employees). 16 17 Section 5. Applicability.

18 The provisions of this act shall not abrogate any provision 19 of an existing collective bargaining agreement or employment 20 contract.

21 Section 6. Effective date.

22 This act shall take effect in 30 days.

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
