#### AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10	Amending the act of July 9, 2008 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), entitled "An act providing for alternative sources of energy; establishing the Alternative Energy Development Program, the Consumer Energy Program, the Home Energy Efficiency Loan Program, the Home Energy Efficiency Loan Fund and the Alternative Energy Production Tax Credit Program; and providing for the powers and duties of the Department of Environmental Protection," further providing for pollution control technology projects; and providing for energy service project grants.
11	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12	hereby enacts as follows:
13	Section 1. Section 304(a) of the act of July 9, 2008 (1st
14	Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), known as the Alternative Energy
15	Investment Act, is amended to read:
16	Section 304. Pollution control technology projects.
17	(a) AllocationThe sum of [\$25,000,000] <u>\$20,000,000</u> shall
18	be transferred by the authority to the department for pollution
19	control technology projects. The funds shall be utilized for
20	grants to electric generating units or cogeneration units, as
21	defined under 25 Pa. Code § 123.202 (relating to definitions),

1	that utilize coal, as defined under 25 Pa. Code § 123.202, as
2	their primary fuel source, and that have an installed capacity
3	of less than 500 megawatts, located in this Commonwealth.

5	Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
6	Section 308. Energy service project grants.
7	The sum of \$5,000,000 shall be used by the department for
8	grants to political subdivisions for energy service project
9	initiatives. The department shall develop guidelines governing
10	implementation of this program.
11	Section 3. The Department of Environmental Protection shall
12	use the sum of \$5,000,000 from funds originally appropriated to
13	it under section 304(a) of the act to fund energy service
14	project grants authorized under section 308 of the act.
15	Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
