## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in certification of teachers, further 5 providing for continuing professional education for school or 6 system leaders. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1205.5 of the act of March 10, 1949 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 12 amended by adding a subsection to read: 13 Section 1205.5. Continuing Professional Education for School 14 or System Leaders. --\* \* \* 15 (c.1) (1) Beginning with the school year that commences after the effective date of this subsection, school or system 16 17 leaders whose school or school district IF EVERY SCHOOL TO WHICH <--A SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER IS ASSIGNED makes adequate yearly 18 progress or shows growth under the value-added assessment system 19 as defined in section 221 for the three prior school years, THEN <--20

- 1 THE SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER shall be exempt from the
- 2 requirements of subsections (a) and (b) FOR EACH YEAR THEREAFTER <--
- 3 UNTIL ANY OF SUCH SCHOOLS FAILS TO MAKE ADEQUATE YEARLY PROGRESS
- 4 OR SHOW GROWTH UNDER THE VALUE-ADDED ASSESSMENT SYSTEM OR UNTIL
- 5 THE SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER IS NO LONGER ASSIGNED TO THE SCHOOLS
- 6 THAT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS FOR EXEMPTION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
- 7 (2) If the school or school district A SCHOOL fails to make <--
- 8 adequate yearly progress or show growth under the value-added
- 9 <u>assessment system in any school year that commences after the</u> <--
- 10 effective date of this subsection, the school or system leaders
- 11 assigned to that school or school district shall comply with
- 12 subsections (a) and (b) until the school or school district
- 13 again makes adequate yearly progress or shows growth under the
- 14 <u>value added assessment system for three consecutive school</u>
- 15 <u>years. IN WHICH ITS SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADERS ARE EXEMPT UNDER</u>
- 16 PARAGRAPH (1), THEN THE SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER ASSIGNED TO THE
- 17 SCHOOL SHALL RESUME COMPLIANCE WITH SUBSECTIONS (A) AND (B) BY
- 18 SATISFYING THE UNMET REQUIREMENTS OF THE COMPLIANCE PERIOD THAT
- 19 THE SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER WAS OBLIGATED TO COMPLETE
- 20 IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO THE EXEMPTION. THE SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER
- 21 SHALL HAVE THE REMAINING DURATION OF THE UNCOMPLETED COMPLIANCE
- 22 PERIOD TO SATISFY THE UNMET REQUIREMENTS BEFORE A NEW COMPLIANCE
- 23 PERIOD BEGINS FOR THE SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER. THE SCHOOL MAKING
- 24 ADEQUATE YEARLY PROGRESS OR SHOWING GROWTH UNDER THE VALUE-ADDED
- 25 ASSESSMENT SYSTEM FOR ANOTHER THREE CONSECUTIVE SCHOOL YEARS
- 26 SHALL STAY THE UNMET COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS AND PERIOD IF THE
- 27 <u>SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER REQUALIFIES FOR EXEMPTION UNDER</u>
- 28 SUBSECTION (C) (1).
- 29 (3) IF A SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER EXEMPT UNDER SUBSECTION
- 30 (C)(1) IS FOR ANY REASON NO LONGER ASSIGNED TO A SCHOOL WITH

- 1 SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADERS WHO ARE EXEMPT UNDER PARAGRAPH (C) (1),
- 2 THE SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER SHALL RESUME COMPLIANCE WITH
- 3 SUBSECTIONS (A) AND (B) BY RESUMING TO SATISFY THE UNMET
- 4 REQUIREMENTS OF THE COMPLIANCE PERIOD THAT THE SCHOOL OR SYSTEM
- 5 LEADER WAS OBLIGATED TO COMPLETE IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO THE
- 6 EXEMPTION. THE SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER SHALL, WITHIN THE
- 7 REMAINING DURATION OF THAT UNCOMPLETED COMPLIANCE PERIOD,
- 8 SATISFY THE UNMET REQUIREMENTS BEFORE A NEW COMPLIANCE PERIOD
- 9 <u>BEGINS FOR THE SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER. THE ASSIGNMENT OF A</u>
- 10 SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER TO A SCHOOL THAT HAS MADE ADEQUATE
- 11 YEARLY PROGRESS OR SHOWS GROWTH UNDER THE VALUE-ADDED ASSESSMENT
- 12 SYSTEM FOR THREE CONSECUTIVE SCHOOL YEARS SHALL STAY THE UNMET
- 13 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS AND PERIOD IF THE SCHOOL OR SYSTEM
- 14 LEADER REQUALIFIES FOR EXEMPTION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1).
- 15 (4) NOTHING IN THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO EXEMPT
- 16 ANY SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER FROM ANY CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL
- 17 EDUCATION REQUIRED BY THE SCHOOL OR SCHOOL DISTRICT TO WHICH THE
- 18 SCHOOL OR SYSTEM LEADER IS ASSIGNED.
- 19 <u>(5) FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE FOLLOWING WORDS</u>
- 20 AND PHRASES SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS
- 21 PARAGRAPH UNLESS THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
- 22 "COMPLIANCE PERIOD" SHALL HAVE THE MEANING GIVEN TO IT UNDER
- 23 SECTION 1205.2.
- 24 "SCHOOL" SHALL MEAN ANY SPECIFIC SCHOOL ADMINISTERED WITHIN A
- 25 SCHOOL DISTRICT.

- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
