- 1 Amending the act of August 21, 1953 (P.L.1323, No.373), entitled
- "An act concerning notaries public; and amending, revising,
- 3 consolidating and changing the law relating thereto," further
- 4 providing for application to become notary public.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 5(a) of the act of August 21, 1953
- 8 (P.L.1323, No.373), known as The Notary Public Law, amended
- 9 December 9, 2002 (P.L.1269, No.151), is amended to read:
- 10 Section 5. Application to Become a Notary Public. -- (a)
- 11 Applications for appointment to the office of notary public
- 12 shall be made to the Secretary of the Commonwealth, on forms
- 13 prescribed and furnished by the secretary, and shall be
- 14 accompanied by a non-refundable filing fee as set forth in
- 15 section 618-A of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175),
- 16 known as "The Administrative Code of 1929," payable to the order
- 17 of the "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania." [Each application shall
- 18 bear the endorsement of the Senator of the district in which the
- 19 applicant resides or, if the applicant does not reside in this

- 1 Commonwealth, the endorsement of the Senator of the district in
- 2 which the applicant is employed. In the case of a vacancy in
- 3 that senatorial district, the application shall be endorsed by
- 4 the Senator of an adjacent district.]

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
